



Visitor Policy

Camp Fish Tales requires that all visitors follow this policy in order to promote the safety of all staff and campers.

- Prior to arrival, all visitors must submit identification for a current background check and must be approved by the camp director. CFT staff members have the right to reject visitors for any reason.
 - Background checks must be current within one year. Please provide driver's license copy.
- All visitors must sign in upon arriving and sign out upon leaving in the main office. A visitor nametag must be worn for the duration of the visit.
- Visitors must be free from any contagious diseases, such as cold or flu, for at least 48 hours before visiting.
- Visitors may not bring weapons of any kind on to camp property.
- During the summer, visitors are welcome during the after-lunch free time (1:00 pm to 2:30 pm) and evening hours (7:00-9:00 pm), Monday-Friday. Visits during other times of the day require prior approval (24 hour notice) from the camp director. CFT recommends that all visitors call ahead to ensure that the time they are visiting will not disrupt programming.
- Due to safety, visitors may not assist with feeding campers, camper personal care, lifts and transfers, or camper medical care.
- Visitors are welcome to spend time in the common areas of camp; these include the dining hall, rec room, and outdoor areas. **Visitors must always be within the line of sight of staff.** Visitors may not be in restrooms, cabins, or anywhere alone with campers. Visitors are welcome to use the restroom outside the main lodge.
- CFT is not responsible for any injuries, losses, or illnesses that result from a visitor's time at camp.
- Any visitors not complying with visitor policies will be asked to leave.
